States With Specific Autism Mandates - ASHA

Several states enacted legislation in 2015 addressing mandated autism coverage including: Colorado, Georgia, Kansas, Missouri, South Dakota, Virginia and Washington. Mandated coverage may be limited to specific age groups, number of annual visits or by an annual spending cap.

Applies to all state employee health benefit plans and large group health benefit plans in the state Coverage is limited to \$50,000 for children ages 1-7, and \$1,000 per month per individual for children ages 7-21.

State employee health benefit (SEHB) plans may be fully insured but are usually self-funded and administered by a state agency. Therefore, benefit design in SEHB plans can also be changed by state government action. All fifty states have taken action to require meaningful coverage for the treatment of autism in state-regulated health plans ...

By 2015, a total of 41 states and the District of Columbia had enacted some level of autism coverage insurance mandates, and 29 states have enacted regulations that require autism coverage to be included on all plans sold through the exchange. But the specifics in the mandates vary significantly from one state to another.

How is autism covered under the Affordable Care Act ...

Out of the 33 states that specify a maximum coverage amount, Wisconsin, Arkansas, South Carolina, and Kentucky are the only states with a maximum yearly coverage amount up to \$50,000, which covers the average cost of ABA Therapy for one year. Nevada has the highest maximum coverage amount at \$75,000 per year.

Health Law Tempers New State Coverage Mandates | Kaiser ...

The state of Texas has a specific autism mandate. The mandate requires a health benefit plan to provide coverage to an enrollee who is diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder from the date of diagnosis until the enrollee completes nine years of age. If an enrollee who is being treated for autism spectrum disorder becomes 10 years of age or older and continues to need treatment, this does not preclude coverage of treatment and services.

Texas Insurance Requirements for Autism Spectrum Disorder

But in 2011, California signed a bill into law that requires behavioral health services, including ABA, to be provided for people with autism spectrum disorders. Many other states have followed, and as of 2013, 34 states mandate ABA coverage for all state regulated health plans.

Information on Essential Health Benefits (EHB) Benchmark ...

The law requires private insurance companies operating in Missouri to provide coverage under group health insurance policies for psychiatric care, psychological care, habilitative or rehabilitative care (including applied behavior analysis (ABA) therapy), therapeutic and pharmacy care to children who have been diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

Due to unwavering advocacy in Tennessee and the fact that 46 other states have mandated coverage for ABA for autism, as of January 1, 2018 Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Tennessee (BCBS-T), UnitedHealthcare (UHC) and Cigna have voluntarily added coverage for ABA in many of their fully insured plans.

In addition, two recent amendments to the Autism and Other Developmental Disabilities mandate were adopted that expand the benefits available to people with autism. One amendment removes the age limit of 21 for ABA, and another removes the 30-visit limit for speech, occupational and physical therapy for autism.
